Application Requirements

Program Overview	This internship program offers participants the opportunity to learn about multicultural coexistence through working and staying in the international environment of ShiriBeshi area in Hokkaido, including the world-renowned tourist destination of “Niseko”, as well as through interactions with local people.
Terms	July to September, <u>including the official term of August 5 to September 4.</u> * Several official events will be held during the official term. *The internship term may vary depending on the host company. Please discuss the schedule directly with the company.

Application Requirements	Applicants must be able to participate throughout the official term and all official events. Applicants must learn about and deepen their understanding of ShiriBeshi area. *There are no restrictions regarding age, gender, place of residence or nationality. Foreign nationals are required to hold a valid visa that permits employment in Japan.
